### Weed Killer

Avenger® Weed Killer is a broad spectrum weed killer that contains d-limonene. D-limonene is the citrus oil that is extracted from the rind of oranges. It is non-selective and controls most annual weeds, both grasses and broadleaves. It is recommended for areas including borders, around driveways, patios and sidewalks, around mature trees and ornamentals, around buildings, in greenhouses containing non-lood crops, fencerows and around flower beds.

Avenger® Weed Killer is fast acting with quick visible results. Foliar contact results in control of annual grasses and broadleaves and top growth reduction of deep rooted perennial weeds. Re-treatment may be required for control of perennial weeds or older, hardier weeds. For best results, shake bottle vigorously and thoroughly coat target weeds. A white emulsion should be visible when spraying to visually mark the sprayed weeds. If this white emulsion is not seen, shake bottle again to ensure complete mixing.

For Control of SMALL ANNUAL WEEDS: Apply Avenger® Weed Killer to the foliage of the small weeds (less than 6 inches) making sure leaves are thoroughly wet and uniformly covered. Do not apply if a strong threat of rain is expected within 2 hours.

For Control of LARGER ANNUAL WEEDS and BURNDOWN of PERENNIAL WEEDS: Larger annual weeds (more than 6 inches) and perennials are more difficult and may require re-treatment. Treat as described above. Best results are obtained when applied to young, actively growing weeds. Weeds that are mature, dormant or hardened due to moisture stress are more resistant to herbicide treatment.

Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.

NOTE: All contacted vegetation is affected. Avoid contacting desirable plants. Overspray or drift will injure or kill contacted vegetation. DO NOT spray on lawns — it will damage or kill treated grass.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place and in such a manner to prevent cross contamination with other pesticides, fertilizers, food and feed. Store in original container and out of the reach of children, preferably in a locked storage area.
